KS2 – KS4 Value Added Measure

KS3 – KS4 Value Added Measure

- value added measure based on progress between prior attainment at KS3 and achievement at KS4 (capped at equivalent of 8 GCSEs)
- percentage of eligible students included in VA calculation (coverage indicator)

GCSE and equivalent achievements of students at the end of KS4

- number of students at the end of KS4
- percentage of students at the end of KS4, aged 14 or less
