

Terms of Reference:

Advisory Group

- Appointment to the Advisory Group is via Full Council Appointment
- The Advisory Group should operate by consensus and not by voting
- The Chairman of the Advisory Group will be nominated by the Group subject to the approval of the Project Board
- The Chairman of the Advisory Group and Members of the Project Board will operate according to the Local Government Code of Conduct.
- The Advisory Group will advise on the development of the project, design and methods.
- The Advisory Group will seek to maximise the professional support available to the Project Board and Project Manager.
- It will consider the progress of the project and make change recommendations to the Project Board.
- Monitor the level of Resource made available to the Project and ensure that it is appropriate
- Ensure that the project addresses aspirations of community groups and other consultees.
- Ensure that the project is sustainable, socially responsible and meets the constraints of the unique environment of the Isles of Scilly.
- To ensure that infrastructure issues that relate to the project are properly considered, including the relationship with other significant capital projects.
- Ensure the integrity of the project and monitor deviations from the original project brief
- To ensure that the project meets the expectation of the Building Schools for the Future Pathways Project
- To ensure that the project will foster excellence in education for children, and the broader community, at this time and for future generations
- To ensure that the New School Build Project develops meaningful links with further and higher education providers to increase opportunities for young people across the islands
- The Advisory Group will have no delegated financial powers.
