Terms of Reference:

New School Community Consultative Group

- 1) Appointment to the Consultative Group is via Full Council
- 2) The Consultative Group should operate by consensus and not by voting
- 3) The Chairman of the Consultative Group will be nominated by the Group subject to the approval of the Project Board
- 4) To ensure that there is early and thorough consultation on the project brief (and site) with all key stakeholders. This will include consultation with the community, staff and governors of the Five Island School, parents, young people, voluntary groups, local clubs and organisations, local businesses, environmental and social groups.
- 5) The group will advise the Project Board via the Project Manager on the most appropriate means of communicating progress to the community.
- 6) The group will act as an information-gathering group and report community concerns to the Project Board via the Project Manager at an early stage to be addressed.
- 7) The group will be regularly and full informed of progress by the Chairman of the Project Board or his appointee
- 8) The Community Consultative Group will have no delegated financial powers.
