## APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO CLOSE PART OF THE HIGHWAY (28 days notice required)

To the Chief Technical Officer, Council of the Isles of Scilly.

### CONDITIONS:

1. Suitable and sufficient warning signs are to be erected in advance of and at the site.
2. The area in question is to be barriered in order to prevent danger to pedestrians or vehicles.
3. The area is to be properly lit at night.
4. The applicant must make formal contact with the following agencies to ensure the work does not impede their access. Where this agreement cannot be reached the Council will assist to find a solution but will be under no obligation to provide alternative arrangements. Police, Fire Brigade, Ambulance Service, H M Coastguard, Road Carrier Services.
5. This permission shall be operative for a specified period and at the end of that period the signs and barriers shall be removed from the Highway and the site thereof left in a clean and tidy condition and any damage to the Highway repaired to the satisfaction of the Chief Technical Officer or his representative.
