

Flooding Advice

Be prepared for flooding

- **Keep a list of useful telephone numbers in an accessible place eg: your local council, plumbers, electricians, builders etc.**
- **Have a few sandbags or floorboards prepared to block doorways.**
- **Make up a Flood Kit, including a torch, blankets, waterproof clothing Wellingtons, a portable radio, first aid kit, rubber gloves and key personal documents. Keep it upstairs, if possible.**
- **Consider the safety of your pets? Where will you move them to if a flood is on the way?**
- **Is there a safe place that you could move your vehicle to in the event of a Flood Warning?**
- **Storing valuable or sentimental personal belongings upstairs or in a high place downstairs.**
- **In the event of a flood you will still need to take any medication. Keep it somewhere safe and accessible.**
