KS1 Moderation Appeals Process

All schools and settings will be supported to ensure that judgements are in line with QCDA exemplification materials and are sound.

When an agreement cannot be reached between the school and the moderator, the moderator will inform the Commissioning, Inclusion and Performance Manager, who will contact the school/setting to address concerns. If required a further moderation visit will be made by the moderation manager and another LA registered moderator.

A report of the visit will be made and the findings will be discussed with the relevant staff members and the Headteacher.

If agreement cannot be reached following the visit of the moderation manager the setting/school can appeal in writing to

The appeal will go forward to a panel of moderators based within our strategic partners, North Somerset LA, who will moderate the judgements and inform the school/setting and Council of the Isles of Scilly of the outcome of the appeal within 28 days of receipt of the appeal.

The decision of the panel will be final.
