Comments:

Thank you for consulting us on this application. We have consulted the Cornwall & Isles of Scilly Historic Environment Record, and note that the proposed building is situated on a site that has previously been subjected to geophysical survey (Sabin and Donaldson 2010) and evaluation (Johns *et al* 2010). The results from these did not suggest that significant archaeological remains not previously recorded would lie within the site. The site also appears to have been extensively landscaped and any remains present are likely to have been removed in any case. In this instance we consider it unlikely that significant archaeological remains will be disturbed by groundworks. No archaeological mitigation is required, and therefore no archaeological condition is sought.
