Thank you for your letter dated 16th May regarding the above planning application which has a direct bearing on our property. We are very conscious that safety must be of paramount concern to all, however we would just like to ask why this necessitates the removal of the pittosporum and all other vegetation from the wall instead of trimming and controlling this as has always been the case in the past. We are sure you are well aware that the plant screening of the car park has been in place since before the original primary school was built and has never caused a problem. What is needed is a speed management scheme to slow the traffic down which will of course aid safety as the traffic has increased since that time.

It will be very sad if we lose yet more of the green screening of the school site. The hedge was always properly trimmed and maintained so that clear sight of the road from the in and out signs was possible - why can this still not be the case? Please inform us what has changed?
