**NOTICE** is given that from 1 July 2016 to 12 August 2016, excluding Saturdays and Sundays and Bank Holidays, between the hours of 09.00am and 4.00pm any person interested may inspect and make copies of the accounting records of the Council of the Isles of Scilly for the year ended 31 March 2016 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers, receipts and other documents relating thereto. The accounts and other documents will be available for inspection at the offices at which they are normally kept or otherwise by arrangement; application should be made initially to the Senior Manager: Finance and Resources, Town Hall, St Mary's (Tel: 01720 424359).

**NOTICE** is also given that from 1 July 2016 to 12 August 2016, excluding Saturdays and Sundays and Bank Holidays, at the request of a Local Government Elector for any area to which the accounts relate, will give the Elector or his/her representative an opportunity to make written objections as to any matter in respect of which the Auditor could take action under Section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. The written notice of objection must state the facts on which the Elector relies, the grounds on which the objection is being made and particulars of:

- i) any item of account which is alleged to be contrary to law; and
- ii) any matter in respect of which it is proposed that the auditor could make a public interest report under section 24 of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 7 to, the Act.

The written notice of objection must be addressed to the Auditor, Grant Thornton UK LLP, of Hartwell House, 55-61 Victoria Street, Bristol, BS1 6FT.
