BRYHER WASTE TRANSFER SITE CLEARANCE WORKS Opportunity to Quote for Works – Deadline 31st March 2015

The Waste and Recycling Team requires the clearance of the Bryher Waste Transfer site to prepare the site for the coming season. This will require the sorting and containerisation of waste into separate waste types ready for shipment to St Marys.

The site will be closed to the public to allow the works to take place.

The successful contractor will be required to provide their own tools and equipment.

The Council of the Isles of Scilly will provide the required containers for each waste stream.

On completion, 100% of the waste on site should be appropriately containerised and ready for removal. Bulky items should be broken down as much as is practicable to maximise space usage in skips.

The transportation of the waste from the waste site to Bryher Quay <u>is not</u> included in this contract.

We require that work is started no later than the 6th April 2015.

Indicative Types of Waste:

| Batteries | Dolav |
| Gas Bottles | Cage |
| Plastics | Skip |
| Bulky Household Items | Skip |
| Small WEEE | Cage |
| White goods | Pallets |

Quotes should be sent to the Waste & Recycling Officer by email to infrastructure@scilly.gov.uk, or by hard copy to the Town Hall. The deadline for quotes is 5pm on the 31st March 2015.

Your quote should include a total fixed price for the works, details of how long the bidder would require the site to be out of service to the public, and the proposed dates for when the works can take place.
