Planning consultation: Isles of Scilly Local Plan Examination. Further submission from Natural England

On 17th December Natural England submitted representations to the Examination including a statement of common ground prepared between the Council and Natural England (SD04). The statement of common ground stated that the only outstanding issue between the two parties related to the conclusions set out in the Habitats Regulations Assessment regarding recreational disturbance.

The Council have updated the Habitats Regulations Assessment report (SD15) and Natural England are now able to concur with the conclusion set out within that report.
