	Gunner Rock 7 Jacksons Hill Hugh Town St Mary's
	Trees in question are 6x cupressus leylandii at eastern end of lower garden of Gunner Rock. Trees are shading garden and crowning out naturalised pittisporum and have been heavily pruned in the past resulting in very little green leaf area below approx2 metres. This type of tree will not respond to pruning techniques to improve the lower green leaf area. Suitable screening is provided further to east by mature and dense line of elm trees. Suggested plan is to remove 6 lleylandii trees
