Council Tax Increased by 3.17% (Council Tax Band D Equivalent)

The proportion of your bill that covers the services provided by the Council of the Isles of Scilly will increase for 2022/23 by 2.99%.

The overall increase for 2022/23 includes the requirement of the Devon & Cornwall Police and Crime Commissioner which increased its proportion of council tax by 4.23%. The combination of these two precepts results in a net increase of 3.17%

Council Tax Precepts and Levies

In addition to the precept for Devon & Cornwall Police the Council is required to pay sums to two other bodies known as levies from the council tax. These bodies and the sums they have levied are as follows:

- Isles of Scilly Inshore Fisheries and Conservation Authority £18,755 to support the work they complete under the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009
- Environment Agency £2,675 for Flood and Coastal Erosion Risk Management Levy

Council Tax Cost to You
