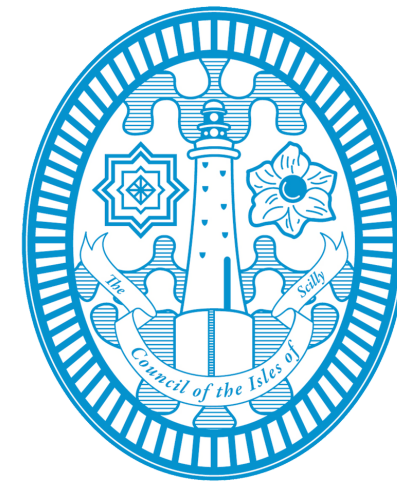


HOUSEHOLD WASTE & RECYCLING GUIDANCE



OFF-ISLANDS | 5th January 2021

For site specific guidance on opening times and social distancing measures, please contact your island waste contractor.

Any residents who are extremely vulnerable and are remaining at home for shielding purposes; symptomatic with coronavirus (COVID-19); in a 14 day household isolation must not visit sites under any circumstances.

SAFE DISPOSAL OF COVID-19 WASTE & RECYCLING

Anyone displaying symptoms of Coronavirus (COVID-19) needs to ensure that all personal waste, such as used tissues and disposable cleaning cloths are:

- double bagged
- both bags are tied up securely
- this waste is kept separate from other waste for 72 hours before being put out for collection/dropped at waste site
- Do not place these items in with your recycling

RECYCLING AND REUSE

Waste reduction, through reuse and recycling, is still really important and can be achieved safely during the pandemic. Please consider reuse and continue to recycle where you can.

ACCEPTED MATERIAL

residual 'black bag' waste', dry mixed recycling in blue bags, hazardous household waste (paint to be hardened first, batteries), rigid plastics, domestic appliances, scrap metal, electrical items and Extra-Ordinary Household Waste (car tyres, plasterboard, brick, stones, ceramics etc.)

Social distancing of 2 metres must be strictly observed. Anyone not complying will unfortunately be asked to leave the site.
