

PRIVACY NOTICE

How we will use the information about you? The Council has a general discretion to grant street trading consent. We will use the information to consider if a licence can be issued, renewed or remain in force. We may use your contact details to provide you with information or to ask your views on certain matters. This could include for example: - Changes in law, policy, or procedures. Provision of training & seminars. Seeking views on customer satisfaction.

Who else will we share your information with? We will use your information in relation to your application and any consent issued. This may include checks with internal and external partners as follows: -Devon and Cornwall Police The Council's; Highways Department Planning Department Planning Department Environmental Health Trading Standards Fire and Rescue Department Licensing Committee Harbour Authority Legal Team

The Council of the Isles of Scilly is under a duty to protect the public funds it administers. To this end we may use the information you have provided on this form for the prevention and detection of fraud. We may share your information with bodies who audit or administer public funds. This would include the Police and the Department for Work and Pensions. Information is also provided to Government Cabinet Office under its National Fraud Initiative.

Safeguards. Your data will need to be held within The Council of the Isles of Scilly secure network and premise. It will not be processed outside of the UK, the EEA. Access to your information will only be made to authorised members of staff. Staff must process it for the purposes outlined in this privacy notice.

 \cdot request that a person reviews an automated decision where it has had an adverse effect on you
