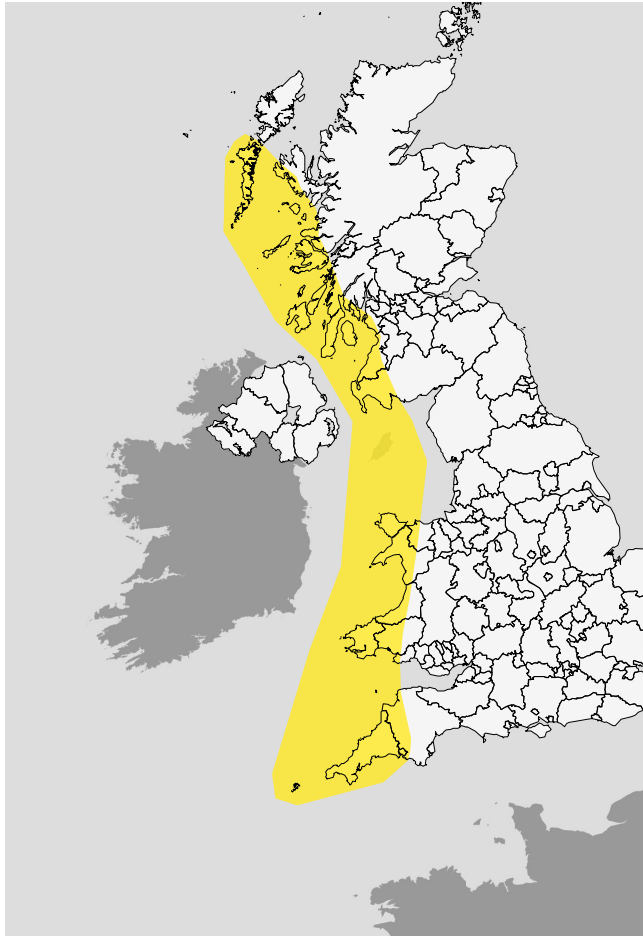




Yellow warning

Strong winds are expected to cause some disruption to travel and power supplies from Wednesday evening to Friday morning.

What to expect

- Some delays to road, rail, air and ferry transport are likely
- Probably some bus and train services affected, with some journeys taking longer
- Delays for high-sided vehicles on exposed routes and bridges likely
- Some short term loss of power and other services is possible
- It's likely that some coastal routes, sea fronts and coastal communities affected by spray and/or large waves
- Some damage to trees with debris on roads are possible given the time of year

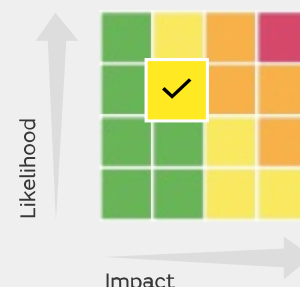

Further details

A spell of strong southerly winds are expected to develop on Wednesday night across southwest England and move north to affect much of the western United Kingdom through the early hours of Thursday morning. Whilst there remains some uncertainty in the exact track of the low, gusts of 55 mph are possible inland, with 65 mph possible around coasts and hills. Whilst winds may temporarily ease during Thursday morning, a band of heavy rain is likely to move east late Thursday afternoon and overnight accompanied by similarly strong, perhaps squally winds.

Reason for update

This warning has been extended north to include parts of western Scotland whilst a separate warning for potentially higher impacts has been issued for Northern Ireland. The end time has also been extended into early Friday morning.
