TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ROAD TRAFFIC (LOWER STRAND, HUGH TOWN, ST MARYS, ISLES OF SCILLY) ORDER 2017

The Council of the Isles of Scilly has made this Order to prohibit any vehicle from using a section of the Lower Strand for a temporary period of 35 days (subject to access to premises) between 13th January 2017 and 17th February 2017, because of the installation and removal of scaffolding for repairs and maintenance to properties in that area.

The closure period will only apply and be in operation as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will also be signed on site where appropriate.

Whilst the order will remain in place until 17th February 2017, it is envisaged that the closure will be operative and works will be carried out during the hours of 8.30am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday and may be complete before the date that the Order expires.

As a result of this prohibition the following measures will take effect:-

On-street parking of motor vehicles will not be allowed on the above mentioned road during the period of the prohibition.

An alternative route for traffic will be sign posted.

This order will come into operation on the 13th January 2017 and may be cited as the TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ROAD TRAFFIC (LOWER STRAND, HUGH TOWN, ST MARYS, ISLES OF SCILLY) ORDER 2017
