Type of Tree- Pinus Radiata (Monterey Pine)

Size- 40ft

Spread- 30ft

Age- approx 40 years

Description- This tree is situated in the North west corner of a field behind Longstone bungalow. It is surrounded by many smaller shrubs and vegetation. It has numerous multi stems protruding from a central stem which is approximately 10ft high and 2ft across. From a visual inspection it looks to be in good health and has outgrown the understory vegetation below.

Comments- I believe this tree has self seeded in this location as it is close by to a pair of very well rotten Monterey stumps near by. In my opinion if this tree were to be removed it would not impact the local ecology as there are larger specimens near by which would be used by nesting birds and dense pine belts in the vicinity which would be used by ground mammals. This tree has the potential to reach 80ft plus and in this surrounding it would be hazardous, even with 20 years growth I could cause damage as it is a stand alone tree, without much shielding from the wind. A safer and more ecologically diverse tree or shrub could be planted in its place such as Hazel, Alder or Elm.
