

# GRANTING OF LISTED BUILDING CONSENT

**Site and particulars of works:** Crebinick House, Church Street, St Mary's Erection of 2 no. self catering suites to be used in conjunction with existing guest house accommodation.

In pursuance of their powers under the above act, the Council hereby PERMIT the above works to be carried out in accordance with the following Conditions:

C1 The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of 3 years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In accordance with the requirements of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended by Section 51 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004).

C2 The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in complete accordance with the details shown on the approved submitted plans 'Block Plan', 'Site Plan' & 'CGH-PA-3a' stamped and dated 25<sup>th</sup> June 2014.

Reason: To define the nature and extent of the development in accordance with Circular 11/95 and for the avoidance of doubt.

Any proposed roof slate, ridge tiles, external cladding, render and rainwater goods to be used in the works hereby permitted, shall accord with samples/details which have first been submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority. The works shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details.

Reason: In order to preserve the character of the listed building in accordance with sections 66 (1), 72 (1) and 16 (2) of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 and section 12 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

Any proposed windows to be used in the works hereby permitted shall be of timber construction C4 except for the proposed roof lights which shall be conservation style, as specified in plan number CGH-PA-3a.

Reason: In order to preserve the character of the listed building in accordance with sections 66 (1), 72 (1) and 16 (2) of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 and section 12 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

## 1 Reasons for Approval for Listed Building Consent

Listed building consent should be granted as permitting the proposed works is not considered to conflict with the duty under Section 66 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 to have regard to the desirability of preserving the listed building or its setting or any features of special architectural or historic interest which it possesses.
