I am in the process of purchasing The Longstone Centre. I have agreed a price with the vendor and a new lease is being agreed with the Duchy.


In line with the current planning permission for development at Longstone I am requesting permission to site some temporary accommodation adjacent to the development site. This will enable me to oversee the project.

There is currently no accommodation on the site and I have no other accommodation. I currently live in temporary accommodation and my tenancy ends at the end of June. I am proposing to erect a single storey, wooden building that will be stylistically sympathetic to the neighbouring wooden buildings. The temporary building will be easily de-mountable once the owners accommodation has been developed.

The first stage of the work at Longstone will be to clear the site around the buildings so that a full site inspection can be achieved, this will then allow detailed architectural drawings to be made. These will be brought back to planning in the autumn.

My vision is to create an innovative learning centre with bunk house accommodation as well as improving the existing catering facilities. This project will be developed in consultation with universities, colleges, research institutions, regional and local partnerships, and the local wildlife trust.
