As Watch Manager of St Martin's Fire Brigade I would also like to object to this due to the fact that with the proposed summer house in place it would then be extremely difficult for the fire tractor and trailer to negotiate the corner for access to the hotel, Sevenstones pub or any other properties beyond that point.
