Dear Mrs.Walton,

During work in progress on the above development I noticed that the windows being installed on the east elevation were much smaller than the ones previously planned. It occurred to me that, with the erection of simple privacy screens, my concerns with being overlooked would be allayed.

If this suggestion is acceptable, I would be happy to see condition 9 modified to allow clear glass opening windows. This is providing that, should larger windows be installed in the future, then appropriate size screens affording privacy would be conditional

I have discussed the above with Mr Lethbridge and we both hope to achieve a satisfactory outcome.
