Hi David

I would like to see if the boundary could be constructed in granite rather than using a timber fence? Is there any way CRHA would be agreeable to this, to the same height as the proposed fence? It would remove the need to take up the space behind the wall in the gap between the wall and the new dwellings in terms of fence post fixings or any bracings? It would result in a much more permanent solution and separation between the development and Lemon Hall and give a much more aesthetically pleasing finish to this development. Overtime the fence will need maintaining whereas a granite wall would not. It may save issues arising in the future.
