Dear Planning Officer,

In response to planning application reference P/15/088/CLE by Mulciber Ltd, I am writing to put forward my objections to the proposals.

It is inappropriate to use the area for waste disposal and storage, quarrying and other industrial purposes.

Pendrathen Quarry has not operated continuously over the last 10 years and has had considerable periods of inactivity.

The decision concerning Pendrathen Quarry should only be considered under the implementation of full planning procedures, which would allow all Residents of the Islands and environmental groups to submit their concerns and ideas.

We must not forget that our beautiful and unique Islands are in an AONB and in Heritage Coastline.

Any proposed change or increase in activities need to have environmental impact studies undertaken, with full consultation with the IoS Wildlife Trust, all marine conservation groups and members of the public.

I feel that it is most important to preserve the natural beauty, tranquility and heritage of our Islands, particularly the area under discussion. The impact of increased traffic movements, noise, dust and disruption through the islands and McFarlands Down, would destroy the unique ambience of our ancient sites.
