I am writing to express my concern that Pendrothe Quarry may be granted ha�t use on the grounds that it has been in "continuous use" over the last ten years. I have been resident in McFarlands Down for over eight years and prior to the use from 2012 I was certainly not aware of activity at the Quarry - if there was it must have been extremely spasmodic - and can that qualify as "continuous use"?

Apart from the aspect of the Quarry being in continual use, I feel that the granting of further use would be detrimental to the immediate area and surely, if it is classed as being within

The increased use of the road would
