Dear Ms Walton

I sent a letter to the Planning and Development Department of the Isles of Scilly Council in June this year, to which you kindly replied.

So upon your suggestion I am re-submitting my letter to you regarding the issue of the claimed regular use of Pendrathen Quarry by Mulcair Ltd. Therefore I repeat for your records that as permanent residents of Minalto, Macfarlands Down, St Marys, Isles of Scilly since May 2002, we support the statement that:

Pendrathen Quarry has not been in any regular use during the last 13 years.

Mr K. Christopher, who lived here for 15 years before us also sent you a letter at that time, to the same effect, so I hope that both originals

have been kept on file so that we back up what is, in effect a change of use to Pendrathen Quarry and to this effect the application should be refused by the Planning Department.

We have also signed a residents' letter submitted by Dr R Hesling further backing our claim.

It is interesting to note that Mulberry Ltd has - like many in the past - to get a 'difficult' application through planning - begun their application while a large number of the population are away on holiday after the summer season, as may well be a full compliment of councillors, all of whom could offer a more balanced view of the whole situation and the negative impact this potential waste disposal site would have on our beautiful environment.
