We herewith submit a planning application for the retention of electronic communication apparatus at the existing Arqiva Transmitting Station for Western Power Distribution (South Wales) Plc. In accordance with both national and local validation list requirements we provide the following: -

This application is made under the provisions of Section 73 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended, and seeks to remove condition 1 of planning permission P/11/049 which limits the permission to a five year temporary period.

The existing development for Western Power Distribution (South Wales) Plc (WPD) is required for the long term and without doubt is for the benefit of businesses and communities on the Isles of Scilly. The development is contained entirely within the existing transmitting station and, notwithstanding the sensitive land designations the site falls within, is a sound environmental solution to meet the identified requirements of WPD.

The reason for the time limiting condition was to take into account the 'rapid changes in technology', however this may be more pertinent to mobile phone technology in respect of software and handsets and not the physical network infrastructure that is needed in this instance. As such a condition requiring the removal of the apparatus when no longer required for the provision of the WPD services would be more appropriate.
