Firstly, we would like to inform you that as stated in the design and access statement, we as neighbours have not approved and supported this proposed application.

The reasons we are not supporting this at present are due to several concerns listed below:

- The front elevation of the proposed extension is mostly glazed and will therefore greatly increase the light pollution to all below including the holiday accommodation.
- The site masterplan shows that part of the wall that exists will be removed to allow steps and access to a lower terrace. Currently this is where the kitchen waste water overflows on to the land, therefore making that area wet and boggy.
- With the new proposed extension we are extremely concerned that noise levels will increase even more for the surrounding residents and visitors in accommodation in Lowertown.
- We also have serious concerns over the new lower terrace being, as stated in the application, a "play area" for youngsters, creating more noise for the surrounding holiday accommodation in a place where they come to enjoy the peace and beauty of Scilly, as do those who live here.
