Thank you for your letter of regarding further information on the above application for listed building consent. On the basis of this information, we offer the following advice to assist your authority in determining the application.

## **Historic England Advice**

We note the application includes a proposal to replace existing cast iron waste pipes with UPVC alternatives. If the existing cast-iron pipe is deteriorated to the point it requires replacement, we would encourage a like-for-like replacement in cast iron. A UPVC alternative will lack the aesthetic quality of cast iron and is likely to have a considerably shorter lifespan, particularly in this exposed Martime location.

Newman House is a Grade II\* listed building, and as the NPPF reminds, us the more important the heritage asset, the greater the weight that should be given to its conservation.

## Recommendation

Historic England has concerns regarding the application on heritage grounds.

Your authority should take these representations into account and seek amendments, safeguards or further information as set out in our advice. If there are any material changes to the proposals, or you would like further advice, please contact us.
