Re: P/17/015/TWA Application to trim branches from one scots pine tree that sits on the edge of the driveway at Sunwood, High Cross Lane, St Mary's Isles of Scilly

Thank you for your application for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 22nd February 2017.

Following a site visit of the Council's Planning Officer I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the tree holds good amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order.

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
