Dear Mr Rogers,

Re: P/17/024/TWA Removal of Bay Tree and Scots Pine adjacent to South of dwelling due to shading and crowding of other species. Deadwood, tidy and clear around telephone line of Monterey Cypress at South Hull, South'ard Bryher, Isles of Scilly.

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 15th March 2017.

Following a recent site visit I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold some amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order.

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
