With regard to the above application, if the concrete base for the new generator is itself new and to be laid on undisturbed ground, then there should be an archaeological recording condition on the basis that the site is adjacent to the Halangy Down SM and close to a dense concentration of known archaeological sites. I would recommend the standard ALGAO text that I sent to you recently.
