Site Address: Luitreth. McFarland's Down, St.Mary's, Isles of Scilly, TR21 0NS

Works Description: Part demolition of existing blockwork garage and erection of timber framing to increase the size of the garage from the original 6.1m x 3.1m to 6.7m x 5.1m, Replacement of existing profile roof with new cement fibre profile roof. New 100mm concrete raft floor laid over the existing garage floor.

Estimated schedule for new construction materials.

- 1. 100mm reinforced concrete floor, 6.7 metres x 5.1 metres. Total 3.5 cubic metres, supplied by Blackwell Building Services (IoS) Ltd.
- 2. 150mm x 50mm tanalised timber for framing and for roof support. Total timber length 110 metres in various lengths, supplied by Blackwell Building Services (IoS) Ltd.
- 3. Stainless steel Riblath mesh, 2m x 1m quantity 11, supplied by Blackwell Building Services (IoS) Ltd.
- 4. Cement render over the Riblath mesh supplied by Blackwell Building Services (loS) Ltd. Quantity 0.2 cu.m.
- 5. Cement fibre sheet roofing in grey colour, 16 sheets 3.0m x 1.0m supplied by Blackwell Building Services (IoS) Ltd.
- 6. Tanalised T&G timber for doors (50m Qty. of 100mm x 19mm x 2.0m supplied by A.R.Taylor shipped to Scilly in container with personal effects by IOS Steamship Co..
- 7. Qty. 2 Plastic window frames 1050mm x 1200mm supplied by Blackwell Building Services (IoS) Ltd.
- 8. Guttering 7m plus 2.2m downpipe, black plastic supplied by Blackwell Building Services (IoS) Ltd.

Waste Management.

- 1. Non-hazardous concrete blocks, approximately 1.0 cu metres, to be recycled by Blackwell Building Services (IoS) Ltd.
- 2. Hazardous roofing sheets Qty 18, approximate sizes 900mm x 1500mm of asbestos cement fibre. This will be double bagged by the builder who is licenced to move asbestos and place it into a skip from Richard Hand Haulage who is licenced to collect and arrange transportation to Penzance. Nick Ferris waste removal services of Penryn will then dispose of the material.
- Any other materials, i.e. plaster, which are not recyclable by the builder will be single bagged by the builder and disposed of by Richard Hand Haulage.
 These will be shipped to the mainland for collection by Jago Skip Hire of Penzance.
