I refer to planning application P/17/054 and would appreciate it if you could answer one or two queries I have regarding this:

2) It appears that the burger van owner was granted a license before a site was found for him. Is this correct and why did it happen?

Why are you therefore proposing to site a mobile food outlet where it will contravene this policy?

6) Why are you proposing to put this site on a busy part of an A road, causing traffic problems, being detrimental to the appearance of the area and also taking up parking spaces?
