Development proposed- Change of use of land to provide a fixed trading site for use by mobile food & beverage business as per the Council's fixed trading policy.

Location- Land at Lower Strand, Hugh Town, St Marys.

On my walks I saw a notice for the above detailed planning application at Lower Strand.

The site as far as I can work out is on the road not in a lay by or a pull in off the road.

Queueing for the said food/beverage will I presume be on the pavement so pedestrians wishing to use the pavement will be forced to walk in the road, half of which has already been taken up by the trading site - a serious accident waiting to happen.

The facilities to be provided are irrelevant in relation to the dangerous situation that pedestrians will be forced into.

The aroma produced by mobile food/beverage business will completely ruin the lives of residents of Lower Strand & the surrounding area.

The smell will penetrate their properties making a normal daily life impossible to live.

Why cannot all mobile food/beverage businesses be sited in one location ie a purpose built site with appropriate facilities away from or on Porthcressa Bank near the T.I.C. where there is plenty of available space?
