- (1) The development to which this permission relates shall be begun not later than the expiration of †[five] [ ] years beginning with the date of this permission.
- (2) Mone of the self catering holiday units shall be used for permanent accommodation with one exception, without prior approval of the Local Planning Authority.
- (3) That any one flat, excluding flat No.3, may be used for supervisory purposes but shall not be occupied by more than one person.

The reasons for the Council's decision to grant permission for the development subject to compliance with the conditions hereinbefore specified are:—

(1) Condition 1 is imposed pursuant to the requirements of Section 41 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

(2) In order to comply with the requirements of Policies 6A and 25 of the Approved Isles of Scilly Structure Plan, which require that the layout and design of residential flats are of sufficiently high standard for permanent accommodation.
