In pursuance of their powers under the above act, the Council hereby **PERMIT** the above development to be carried out in accordance with the following Conditions:

C1 The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In accordance with the requirements of Section 18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 (as amended).

- C2 The development hereby permitted, shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details only including:
 - o The Location Plan, on A4.
 - o Proposed Site Plan, on A4.
 - Proposed Plans, drawing number: 1230

Reason: For the clarity and avoidance of doubt and in the interests of the character and appearance of the Conservation Area, Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Heritage Coast in accordance with Policy 1 of the Isles of Scilly Local Plan 2005.

PRE-COMMENCEMENT CONDITION – Archaeological Written Scheme of Investigation

C3 A) No development shall commence until a programme of archaeological work including a Written Scheme of Investigation has been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority in writing. The scheme shall include an assessment of significance and research questions, and:

- The programme and methodology of site investigation and recording
- The programme for post investigation assessment
- Provision to be made for analysis of the site investigation and recording
- Provision to be made for publication and dissemination of the analysis and records of the site investigation.
- Provision to be made for archive deposition of the analysis and records of the site investigation.
- Nomination of a competent person or persons/organisation to undertake the works set out within the Written Scheme of Investigation
- B) No development shall take place other than in accordance with the Written Scheme of Investigation approved under condition (A).
- C) The development shall not be occupied until the site investigation and post investigation assessment has been completed in accordance with the programme set out in the Written Scheme of Investigation approved under condition (A) and the provision made for analysis, publication and dissemination of results and archive deposition has been secured.

Reason: This is a pre-commencement condition that requires details that were not submitted as part of the application, but are required to fully understand the impact upon the Islands archaeological, historic and built environment, to be submitted and agreed by the Local Planning Authority. This is to ensure those characteristics which contribute to the status of the Isles of Scilly as a Conservation Area, Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Heritage Coast are preserved or enhanced. In accordance with the requirements of Policy 1 of the Isles of Scilly Local Plan 2005.

The building, hereby approved, shall be constructed with anthracite grey, cement fibre roof sheets and translucent sheets, as shown on the approved plans, unless otherwise previously agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority. The roof shall be covered and maintained in the approved material thereafter.

Reason: In the interests of the appearance of the development and to ensure the development harmonises with its surroundings in the interests of the visual amenities and character of this area.

C5 In addition to Condition 4, the building hereby approved shall be constructed with timber boarding to the external elevations as shown on the approved plans, unless an alternative material has previously been agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority. The elevations shall remain externally clad with the agreed material thereafter.

Reason: In the interests of the appearance of the development and to ensure the development harmonises with its surroundings in the interests of the visual amenities and character of this area.

C6 The development hereby approved shall be used solely for the purposes of agriculture or horticulture as defined under Section 336 of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990.

Reason: To ensure that the development hereby permitted is used solely for the purposes of agriculture and horticulture.

PRE-INSTALLATION CONDITION – Site Waste Management Plan

C7 Prior to installation on the building hereby approved, details of external lighting or floodlighting to be installed shall be submitted to and agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority. Such details shall include the position of the light(s) on the building, its design and direction of light beam. The external lighting shall thereafter be installed in accordance with the agreed details.

Reason: To retain control over external lighting in the interests of visual amenity.
