

## Downs Farm Agricultural Building Statement

Here is a short statement of the Design/Access/disposal of waste/and foundations.

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PLANNING DEPARTMENT  
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The building to be constructed is a Fingle Farm construction that is 15x8 and the roof is anthracite grey 150mm (6") corrugated british marley eternit fiber cement with matching ridge and barge boards. The cladding will be timber lapped boarding from roof level to floor level. At one end will be 3.0m x 3.0m slideing door. Deep flow in black PVC Gutters.

Foundations will consist of a 15m x 8m x 100mm slab onto exiting layer of ram.

Access will be threw the existing downs farm entrance. And will not be visible from the public road.

The building should be tucked down below tree line and therefore will blend in to the surroundings.

Disposal of surplus top soil will be spread on the farm. And rock will be used as hard core on the farm.
