P/18/006/TWA: Pollarding of 3 no Elm Trees at Sally Port, St Mary's

Thank you for the above notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated received on 26th January 2018.

I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees are in a prominent position in the street scene, they hold limited amenity value. On this basis it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate and acceptable. The Council do not intend to protect any of the trees further through a Tree Preservation Order.

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
