Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

REFERENCE	P/18/009/TWA
WORKS PROPOSED:	Removal of two elm trees that sit close to the electric supply and foundations of the property and trimming of a number of other elm trees.
LOCATION:	Nowhere, Old Town Road, Old Town, St Mary's, Isles Of Scilly, TR21 0NH

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 8th February 2018. Following a site visit of the Council's Planning Officer I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold good amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
