**Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area**

**WORKS PROPOSED:**

Works to Canary Island palm tree, including removal of overhanging branches, removal of olearia growth from the crown, and removal of aeonium growth on trunk. Also trimming back adjacent cabbage palms.

**LOCATION:**

Crows Nest, The Bank, Hugh Town, St Mary's, Isles of Scilly, TR21 0HY

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 13th February 2018. Following a site visit of the Council's Planning Officer I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold good amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees.
