Thanks for your patience and apologies for the lack of updates on this. Mindful of the timescales, we are happy to agree the extension of time to 14 November as suggested.

Many thanks for your email and your time on the phone earlier. Having now discussed with my client, I can confirm that we are agreeable to the proposed extension of time to 14 September.

In respect of the approach discussed and agreed in principle, I would summarise this as follows:

- a. Instruct a full topographical survey of the site (to an arbitrary datum the key information is how levels relate to one another, rather than to the surroundings)
- b. Revise the site layout to achieve the 6m separation, seeking to minimise variance in levels beneath any single platform
- c. Update the LVIA accordingly, considering whether the visual impacts remain within an acceptable range
- d. Produce an indicative elevation/section detail of the unit with the most severe drop in ground levels beneath
- e. Submit this package of information to you, together with an accompanying covering letter

Subject to your review and general satisfaction with the above, we would then look to instruct a qualified archaeologist to produce an additional survey of the site and assess the prospective impacts of the development on surface and potential buried archaeology, as well as the setting of the nearby monument. Further to the above application. I am writing to advise you that this application has been called in for a Full Council decision. I am mindful that this application does expire however on the 23rd August 2018. I would therefore like to agree with you an extension of time until the 14th September to allow sufficient time for the additional information to be submitted, any necessary re-consultation and to ensure a report can be written in time for this Council meeting.

Having reviewed the consultation response from Cornwall Archaeological Unit, I think that a heritage assessment of some form should be submitted to demonstrate full consideration of the historic nature of this site has been made in relation to the application. I am unable to confirm whether such additional information would satisfactorily address the historic environment

impact concerns raised by Cornwall Archaeological Unit but I consider there to be sufficient justification to require this information. I do understand that it would have an additional cost implication but I do not consider we would be in a position to conclude on this without an assessment being submitted. I consider it would be difficult for us to assess the visual impact of the proposal on any existing up-standing archaeology as there are no detailed plans in relation to the elevation and levels of each of the proposed tents and associated platforms.

Mindful of the advice that we undertake further assessment work, can I just seek confirmation that the author understands that the quoted reference to my statement Para 6.20 "known site of..." refers to the Scilly Isles archipelago as a whole, and not specifically to the application site? Reading the comments, I am just a little concerned that this has been misunderstood, though I feel that Para 6.20 is unambiguous in its wording.

Of course, it may be that the request for additional work may stand in any case, which is fine. Again, though, (Lisa) can you confirm that you are formally requesting this as part of the consideration of the application?

Given the time and costs associated with such an exercise, we may seek to address the outstanding issues in terms of levels, layout, etc, first, with a view to reaching agreement in principle on the 'above ground' elements of the scheme. This would then provide some reassurance that further heritage investigation/reporting is worthwhile. Would you agree with this approach?
