I do not object to work being done on the property but the plans show substantial changes in footprint of outbuildings and the height of Bank Cottage which will change the appearance of that iconic part of Bryher which is one of the most photographed and painted parts of the Scilly Islands. The views from Great Porth, Sampson and other hills on Bryher will be significantly changed with the level of development proposed.

The other objection is for the resulting loss of light into Atlanta Cottage kitchen, lounge, and front bedroom if the roof ridge height of Bank Cottage is raised by 1.2m.

If planning permission is given to these plans, as regular visitors to Atlanta Cottage over 30 years, this may well make us rethink our visit to Atlanta Cottage each year.
