I am writing in regard to the planning application to Bank cottage on Bryher in the Isles of Scilly. Reference P/18/075

Firstly, I am not a resident of the island, but holiday on Brhyer and the other islands yearly and have done so for many years, too numerous to mention. I hope that my opinion would be of some relevance.

The proposed plans would mean raising the roof line by one and a half metres, therefore considerably blocking the view from Atlanta Cottage and taking much light away. While I realise that no one “has a right to a view” I would have thought the wonderful paneramic view which the proposers property already enjoys, should mean more consideration to neighbouring properties and therefore be incorporated in their proposals.

One must also take into account the precarious existence of these Islands and running a holiday business by many of the Islanders means thinking how one action effects the others. Taking the view and reducing the light from Atlantic Cottage in my opinion may have a detrimental affect to the owners and the numerous holiday makers who visit and help keep the economy afloat.
