## **Comments:**

Thank you for consulting us on this application. We have consulted the Cornwall and Scilly Historic Environment Record and note that a bowl quern and an additional fragment (MCO30674) were found at Holy Vale, indicating prehistoric activity, likely to be settlement, in the vicinity. Whilst the footprint of the proposed building is smaller than that of the current building there is the potential for remains to be identified below that footprint, in the stripping/levelling for the car parking spaces (if any groundworks are proposed for this), and in the trench for the proposed septic tank and connections. Therefore we would recommend a watching brief during groundworks, subject to a standard archaeological recording condition attached to planning permission.
