

## **Waste Management Plan – The Hump, St Agnes**

Location of site – The Hump, St Agnes, Isles of Scilly TR22 0PL

Project – removal of corrugated asbestos roofing sheets, make good roof, batten felt and fit double roman tiles

Client – Adrian Pearce, Atlantic Cottage, St Agnes, Isles of Scilly TR22 0PL

Principal contractor – Ben Hicks, Tamarisk Farm, St Agnes, Isles of Scilly TR22 0PL

Date works start – November 2019

Date completion – February 2020

### **Waste Management Plan**

The Hump is a single storey detached building accessed from St Agnes main road across a field owned by client

Waste will be sorted on site into 1 tonne dumpy bags, supported underneath on pallets and tied on top to prevent spillage

Transport by vehicles already on St Agnes to quay freight and waste area to enable transport via Richard Hand Haulage to mainland

Household waste from contractors to be removed each day by contractors, and not stored on site

Pallets for bought-in materials re-used for waste dumpy bags

### **Waste categories**

Asbestos sheeting – 1 x 8x4 pallet double-wrapped in plastic and shipped to the mainland by specialist haulage

Plastic – 1 x dumpy bag on pallet to Richard Hand haulage

Timber – de-nailed and re-used on site

Roofing tiles off-cuts – half dumpy-bag re-used in concrete mix on island

Because of the nature of the project there will be minimal amounts of waste

The materials are sourced: Timber and battens from RGB Porthleven, Double-roman tiles existing stock situated on St Agnes
