Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

WORKS PROPOSED:

Trees in question are 6x cupressus leylandii at eastern end of lower garden of Gunner Rock. Trees are shading garden and crowning out naturalised pittosporum and have been heavily pruned in the past resulting in very little green leaf area below approx 2 metres. This type of tree will not respond to pruning techniques to improve the lower green leaf area. Suitable screening is provided further to east by mature and dense line of elm trees. Suggested plan is to remove 6 leylandii trees

LOCATION:

Gunners Rock, 7 Jacksons Hill, Hugh Town St Mary's

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 13th August 2019. Following a site visit of the Council's Planning Officer I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold some amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect these trees further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
