## Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

**REFERENCE:**

P/19/049/TWA

**WORKS PROPOSED:**

Works to tress on the west boundary with "Chy Carn" consisting of four lodgepole pines (Pinus Contorta) mixed with pittosporum in hedge. Works will reduce hedge by approx two metres in height.

**LOCATION:**

Tremellyn, Church Road, St Mary's

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2019. Following a site visit of the Council's Planning Officer I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold some amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect these trees further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).

If the works are not executed within two years of the date of this letter you are required to notify the Council's Planning Department again of your intention to undertake work to the trees. The work could be carried out in accordance with good practice as set out in "British Standards Recommendation for Tree Work" BS3998.
