I arrived back from overseas today. I see that there is an amended plan for the shed in the front garden of 36 Ennor Close (amended plan dated 19th February 2020). I am emailing you as there is no time in which to write a response.

I note that the proposed position of the shed does not block the gated access to either 12 or 14 Ennor Close and allows a one metre gap from the rear fences of 12 and 14 Ennor Close as per the original amended plans for the construction of 36 Ennor Close. Thus, the proposed shed in no way infringes on our right to access through 36 Ennor Close and we therefore have no objection to the amended plan.
