I am writing to contest the planning Application -  
P/20/003/HH.

While I have no objection to the erection of a garden shed in the front garden of 36, Emorclose, I object to the siting of the shed, as it will block my right of access to the rear of my property (12, Emorclose). I was assured in, writing, by the planning department on the purchase of my property, that when the bungalows were built, I would still have right of access to the rear of my property. I was asked on a recent visit by a fire officer if I had rear access in case of fire or emergency and I was able to prove that I had.

Also, rear access is needed for the delivery and removal of large items of furniture. Also by blocking the access it may set a precedent to the eventual blocking of the other residential properties who also have the right to rear access.

However, if the occupiers of 36, Emorclose are willing to pay for the resiting of my rear gate, then I will reconsider my objection on receipt of their written assurance.
